I give and bequeath all the real and personal estate of whatever kind or nature of which I shall die possessed unto my dear wife Jane Skeate subject nevertheless to the payment of my just debts, funeral expenses and the costs and charges of proving this my last will to hold the same unto and to the use of the said Jane Skeate, her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns absolutely and I hereby appoint my said dear wife, Jane Skeate, sole executrix of this my will. In witness whereof, I have hereunder set my hand this ninth day of April, one thousand, eight hundred and forty four. *Ralph Skeate*. Signed by the said Ralph Skeate as and for his last will and testament in the presence of us who being present at the same time and in the presence of each other have subscribed our names as witnesses.
